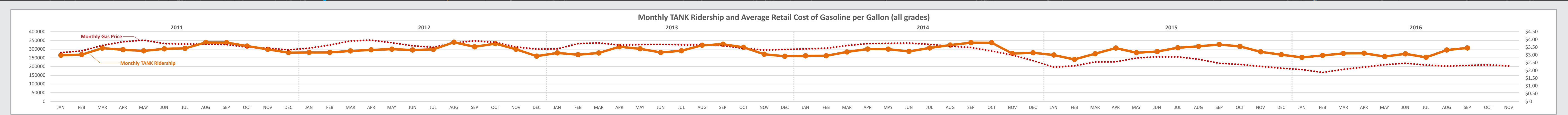
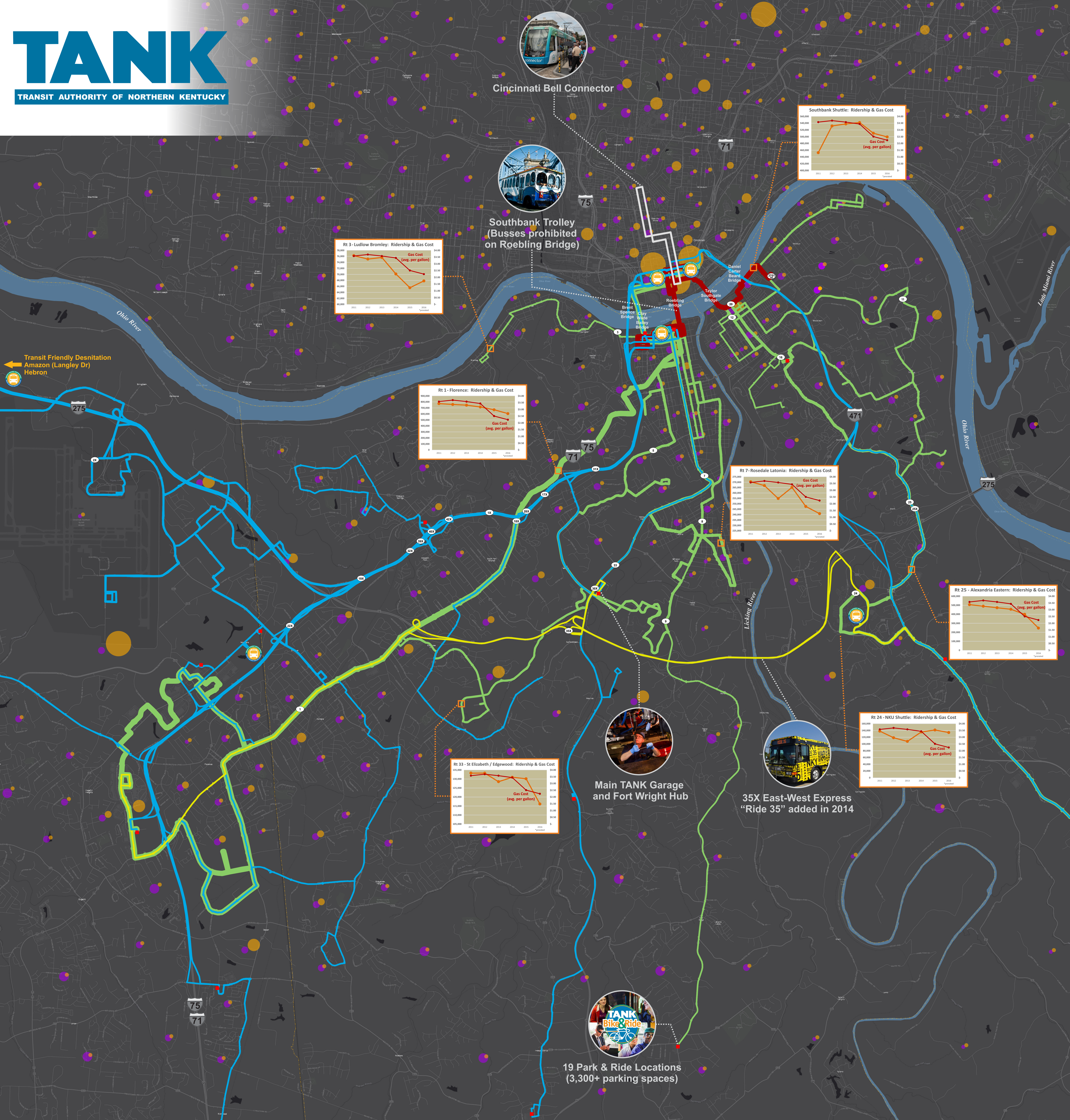

TANK's operations are dramatically affected by factors often outside of their control, particularly the **interrelationship between gas prices and transit ridership on their system**. Analysis shows marked increases in ridership as fuel prices increase.

TANK had the lowest number of preventable accidents in 2015 since 2007. TANK uses very strict standards when determining whether or not an accident is defined as "preventable." There were 6.51 preventable accidents per 400,000 miles traveled in 2015.

Kenton County's public transportation is provided by TANK. Today TANK operates more than 130 buses in the three county region. TANK is an important partner in the economic growth of the region and is committed to develop a comprehensive transportation network for the community.
